Safety Plan for In-Person Children's Ministry

(opening on September 20)

The health and safety of our children and volunteers are our upmost priority. Here are the steps we are taking to keep our team and kids as safe as possible.

CLEANLINESS

- (1) The children's building is cleaned and sprayed with NDC product (on the CDC "N" list and confirmed to kill Covid-19). Fresh air is brought in through the AC system. Smaller classrooms will have air filters in the room. Toys are cleaned before each service. Toys that cannot be cleaned have been removed from the classrooms.
- (2) The playgrounds are spot cleaned. Plastic items/play equipment are sprayed with NDC (see above).
- (3) All Staff/Volunteers will wash their hands upon arrival and are only permitted to serve if they are healthy (see Protocol for Entry below). Staff/Volunteers will use hand sanitizer regularly and will have a mask on at all times.
- (4) We ask that kids in 1-6 grade wear their masks upon arrival/pickup and when not able to social distance, such as playtime, etc. Elementary kids can remove their masks during lesson time when we are seated 6 feet apart. Masks are optional for preschoolers.
- (5) Kids will use hand sanitizer upon arrival and throughout the morning to stay sanitized.
- (6) Food and snacks will be individually sealed. No food will be shared between kids.
- (7) Should a child or adult that participated in BVKids Sunday morning ministry be positive for Covid-19, those who were in close contact (6 feet for 15 minutes or more) will be notified by BVKids Staff.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

IF YOU ARE CHECKING IN AT THE KIDS BUILDING

- (1) Checkin/out will be at the door of the Kids Building.
- (2) Parents/Guardians will check their child in at the door and a BVKids Staff/Volunteer will walk each child to their classroom. Parents/Guardians will sign in via computer (and receive a name tag and pick up tag) or sign in manually and receive a name tag and pick up tag.
- (3) Kids will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon check in.
- (4) Check out will also be at the door of the Kids Building. BVKids Staff/Volunteer will bring each child to the door at the right time for pick up. Parents/Guardians will present their pick up tag to the Staff/Volunteer to ensure each child goes home with the correct guardian.
- (5) Please ring the door bell if you need to reach a Staff member or Volunteer at anytime.

IF YOU ARE CHECKING IN AT THE OUTDOOR PLAYGROUND

- (1) Parents/Guardians will check their child in at the Outdoor Playground. A BVKids Staff/ Volunteer will be available at the opening gate to the playground for check in. Once kids are checked in, kids are free to come onto the playground.
- (2) Parents/Guardians will sign in manually and receive a name tag and pick up tag.
- (3) Kids will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon check in.

PROTOCOL FOR ENTRY:

Every child, staff member and volunteer will be asked if they have (and must have none of the following) symptoms of COVID-19 before participating in BVKids Children's Ministry:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees
- Known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19

If a child, staff member or volunteer has been in known close contact with a person that is labconfirmed to have Covid-19, they will be able to participate in BVKids after a 14 day selfquarantine period from the last date of exposure.

If a child, staff member or volunteer is diagnosed with Covid-19, they may participate in BVKids when all 3 of the following are met: (1) at least 72 hours have passed since recovery (a lab-confirmed negative Covid-19 test); (2) the individual has improvement in respiratory symptoms, and; (3) at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
